The view toward our beach from Hartstene Island 4 miles across Case Inlet in South Puget Sound.

Our beach is a white dot in the center of the photo. Mt Rainier is about 60 miles beyond.

We can't see the mountain from our property but it comes into view if we sail about 3 miles out.

With our backs toward that mountain we have a wide view of the Olympic range, now in final stages of snow melt-down.

The tide rises and falls twice a day from a low of minus 4 feet to a high of 16'.

On the occasions when our Cabin has been broken into during the winter we always remind ourselves..."They'll never steal the true valuables...the view, the water and the beach."

But all this does not block my wider "view."

CAN YOU HEAR THEM CRY?

A whale surfaced very close offshore... then disappeared on its quest not before some photos were taken.

Sitting in the rocker on our far deck
I can "see" far across the water to the mountains
and way back in time to other whales.

Like just 50 years ago to Vaughn Bay... abour five miles north hidden by a sand spit... where Orca's were captured for Marine World.

I still "see" the boats driving whales into the bay...
the nets and loading equipment to haul them...
to be sold and sent from their home waters.

never to be together again.
